

## A Word From Pastor Fred -

In April, 1988 the evening news reported on a photographer who was also a skydiver. He had jumped from a plane along with several other skydivers and filmed the group as they individually dove out of the plane and opened their parachutes.

As the video was being shown of each member of the crew jumping out and then pulling their rip cord so that their parachute opened to the wind, the final skydiver opened his chute and then the picture went berserk. The announcer reported that the cameraman had fallen to his death, having jumped out of the plane without a parachute.

It wasn't until he reached for the ripcord that he realized he was free falling without a parachute. Up until then, he was enjoying himself, completely absorbed in what he was doing. Tragically, though, he was unprepared for the jump. It did not matter how many times he had done it before or what skill he had. By forgetting the parachute, he made a foolish and deadly mistake. Nothing could save him, because his faith was in a parachute which he had never taken the trouble to buckle on.

Preparation is important. Obviously, it's important in sky-diving. It's important in athletics. It's important in school. It's important at work. But much more than in all those situations, preparation is important in eternity.

This morning, as we look together at Luke 12:35-48, we're going to think about why and how to prepare for eternity. What does it mean to prepare for eternity, and how do we do it? What did Jesus have to say about being ready for His return?

I hope you'll join us tonight for our Trunk or Treat Fall Festival! We always have a blast at this annual outreach, and we will have hundreds of people on our campus. Let's show up, dress up, and be the hospitable, loving church we are known to be.
